First, thank you for volunteering to be the President. You are the voice of Vernon Baseball and represent all of your coaches, umpires, players, and parents. All issues and concerns on and off the field will be directed through you. You are responsible for the planning and execution of a successful season. Below is a list of the common duties of the President. If you have questions that have not been answered here, please seek support from Vernon Baseball Executive.

Role

The President's primary responsibility is to provide leadership, mentoring & direction in the formation and execution of the Vernon Baseball Executive Team. In addition, the President must communicate effectively with Vernon Baseball Executive, coaches, umpires and parents as required. Finally, the President must facilitate a healthy, fun and educational environment for kids, coaches and parents; and inspire the principals of sport through the game of baseball.

Duties

Monthly Meetings: Develop & facilitate the agenda for monthly Vernon Baseball Executive meetings to discuss league topics. Vote on changes to policy, expenditures and contribute new Ideas. Understand Vernon Baseball policies, Code of Conduct and the rules that apply to each division.

BC Baseball: Act as the primary representative and point of contact between Vernon Baseball and BC Baseball. This includes attending all meetings on a regular and as required basis, responding to special requests for information or action and completion of all standard administrative tasks & paperwork throughout the year.

AGM: Chair the annual Vernon Baseball AGM in order to provide a public recap of the previous season and establish a new Executive Team for the year ahead.

Finances: Guard the overall financial health of Vernon Baseball by monitoring & managing association expenditures and securing adequate revenues in accordance with the annual budget established with the Treasurer.

Accountability: Hold each Executive Team Member accountable to perform their individual duties in a timely & appropriate manner.

Disputes: Resolve all internal and/or external disputes that arise involving Vernon Baseball members or the association overall.

Coach Selection: Participate in the selection process for AAA, AA and Summer Team Coaches within all divisions.

Fields: Create an annual field's contract in coordination with each Division Director and the City of Vernon. Identify opportunities to lead initiatives that provide long-term field & facility improvements that benefit current & future Vernon Baseball members.

Summary: This job title comes with year round leadership responsibility. Planning ahead and utilizing the executive is the top priority. Being a good communicator and having the ability to work with others is a must. The President has the full support of the Executive. Be creative, Vernon Baseball is always looking for ways to improve.
